Please note: this is a voluntary position, but travel expenses will be paid by prior agreement.

Anticipated workload: Attendance at two meetings per year (most likely at SportPark in Loughborough). With regular communication between meetings and some individual research scoping or activity undertaken.

Skills/Competencies required:

- 1) Experience of breaking down barriers to participation for under-represented groups.
- 2) Knowledge of, connections to, or experience in, representing/working with unrepresented groups and communities in England. Groups can include those with disabilities. Communities include mixed race Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Asian and Filipino.
- 3) Experience/evidence of successful communication/engagement with the above, specifically face to face, language etc.
- 4) Experience of establishing successful groups/projects/interventions following work with unrepresented communities.
- 5) An interest in volleyball.
