v. Men's and Women's Super 8s

- (3) The team finishing 8th will be relegated to Division 1 for 2012-13.

vi. Men's Division 1

- (1) The winners of the Division will be promoted to the Super 8s for 2012-13.
- (2) The team finishing 2nd will play off against the 7th placed team in the Super 8s. The winner will play in the Super 8s in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 1. This match will be played at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared.
- (3) The team finishing 8th in Division 1 will playoff in a triangular against the two 2nd placed teams in Division 2. The winner will play in Division 1 in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 2. The fixture will take place at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared.
- (4) The teams finishing 9th & 10th will be relegated to Division 2 for 2012-13.

vi. Women's Division 1

- (1) The winners of the Division will be promoted to the Super 8s for 2012-13.
- (2) The team finishing 2nd will play off against the 7th placed team in the Super 8s. The winner will play in the Super 8s in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 1. This match will be played at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared.
- (3) The team finishing 9th in Division 1 will playoff in a triangular against the two 2nd placed teams in Division 2. The winner will play in Division 1 in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 2. The fixture will take place at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared.

vii. Men's Division 2

- (1) The winners of each Division will be promoted to Division 1 for 2012-13.
- (2) The 2nd place teams in the Divisions will playoff in a triangular against the 8th place in Division 1. The fixture will take place at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared. The winner will play in Division 1 in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 2.
- (3) The teams finishing 9th & 10th will be relegated to Division 3 for 2012-13.

vii. Women's Division 2

- (1) The winners of each Division will be promoted to Division 1 for 2012-13.
- (2) The 2nd place teams in the Divisions will playoff in a triangular against the 9th place in Division 1. The fixture will take place at a central venue organised by VE with the costs shared. The winner will play in Division 1 in 2012-13 and the losers in Division 2.
- (3) The teams finishing 9th & 10th will be relegated to Division 3 for 2012-13.

viii. Men's Division 3

- (1) The winners and Runners Up of the Division will be promoted to Division 2 for 2012-13.
- (2) The bottom two teams in each Division maybe required to seek re-entry and maybe required to participate in playoffs

- (1) The winners and Runners Up of the Division will be promoted to Division 2 for 2012-13.
